

Apple Valley POA Outdoor Pool Closure Procedure

Keeping Our Pool Safe and Enjoyable!  

1. Temperature-Related Closures

The pool will remain closed if the air temperature is below 70°F (21°C) at the scheduled opening time.

If the water temperature falls below 78°F (25.5°C) and cannot be safely or comfortably maintained, the pool may be closed at the discretion of HOA management or pool staff.

Reason: Low temperatures can make swimming uncomfortable and increase the risk of hypothermia. Additionally, maintaining the pool at a comfortable temperature may not be feasible during colder weather.

2. Foul Weather Closures

The pool will be closed immediately and remain closed during the following conditions:

- Lightning or thunder: The pool will close at the first sign of lightning or thunder and will remain closed for 30 minutes after the last occurrence.
- Tornado Warnings
- Heavy rain: If rainfall significantly reduces visibility in the pool, it will be closed until conditions improve.
- High winds: Sustained winds or gusts that create unsafe conditions or blow debris into the pool area will result in closure.
- Hail or sleet: The pool will close immediately during any of these weather events.

3. Reopening Procedures

The pool will reopen only when weather conditions have improved and it is deemed safe by HOA management or designated pool staff.

A safety inspection will be conducted before reopening to ensure the pool and surrounding area are free of hazards.

4. Communication

Closure notices will be posted at the pool gate and communicated via AVPOA-approved channels (e.g., email, text alerts, or avpoa.com website).

Residents are encouraged to check for updates before heading to the pool.
